Application fee

A non-refundable application fee of £120 is payable at the time of application.

Acceptance deposit

On accepting a place, an acceptance deposit of £750 is payable. This is automatically refunded after the pupil has left.

Fees payment

Fees are payable monthly via direct debit or in termly instalments.
