Scholarship application

With only 40 places available, admission to Year 7 at Babington House School is extremely competitive.

We are looking for children whose skills and talents extend beyond the curriculum and who will contribute to the rich life of our thriving community. We take the time to get to know every child through the admissions process and our Taster Days, exploring their personalities, talents, aspirations and a school reference.

To be considered for a scholarship you will need to:

- 1) Submit an application form to register for our entrance exam and pay the £120 registration fee.
- 2) Submit our Scholarship application form. The deadline for application is **Monday 10th** November 2025.

Entrance examination

Our entrance examination consists of:

English – 40 minutes

Maths – 40 minutes

Online test (Vocabulary, proof reading, spelling, punctuation, grammar, perceptual speed & accuracy and non-verbal reasoning) – 40 minutes.

The examination will take place on **Saturday 10th January 2026** where candidates will spend either the morning or afternoon at Babington House School. Our admissions registrar will confirm exact times closer to the date.

Drama Scholarship

The assessment process

We are delighted that you are considering applying for a Drama Scholarship at Babington House School. Candidates will take part in a Drama Workshop as part of the assessment process, which will take place during the week commencing Monday 24th November 2025. You will receive an individual invitation confirming the exact date and time of your session.

Workshop Overview

The Drama Workshop will last approximately one hour and will be followed by a group interview. During the workshop, candidates will be assessed on their ability to:

- Collaborate creatively with others and communicate ideas effectively
- Improvise and respond spontaneously to different scenarios
- Use movement and physicality in an imaginative, non-naturalistic way to portray objects, animals, shapes, or abstract ideas.

Monologue Performance

Candidates will be sent a monologue in advance, which they will be expected to prepare and perform during the workshop. This element is designed to assess:

- The ability to learn and deliver a scripted piece
- Use of voice, expression, and movement to create character and atmosphere
- Vocal range and overall performance skills

Group Interview

After the workshop, candidates will take part in a group interview. This is an opportunity for students to:

- Share their thoughts on drama and performance
- Respond to questions about their experiences and interests in the subject
- Demonstrate their ability to listen, contribute, and work collaboratively in discussion.

Drama Portfolio

Candidates are encouraged to bring a portfolio of their drama experience on the day. This may include:

- Photos, programmes, certificates, or awards from drama productions, workshops, or clubs
- Evidence of drama-related achievements or activities
- Written reflections or supporting material that showcase their passion for the subject.

Portfolios should be clearly labelled with the candidate's full name and will be discussed during the group interview.

Please note: Dance experience is not required for this scholarship and will not form part of the assessment.

Selection Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded based on the candidate's performance during the workshop and group interview. We are looking for young performers who demonstrate:

- Confidence and creativity
- A collaborative and open-minded attitude
- Strong performance potential and enthusiasm for drama.

Art Scholarship

The assessment process

The Art scholarship may be offered to a candidate with exceptional abilities in Art and Design. Applicants will be invited to attend a timed assessment which will take place during the week commencing 24th November 2025. Your invitation will state the date and time. Candidates applying for this scholarship will be asked to submit a portfolio of their work.

Portfolio of work

It is expected that the portfolio will show the candidate's personal skills and abilities in connection with the artistic process. Please include all work which demonstrates personal creative skills. This may include:

- School-based projects
- Home-based related hobbies and activities
- Work from any Art workshops attended
- Illustrated written work
- Studies on an artist you admire
- Scrapbooks, sketchbooks, photographs, 3-dimensional work (must be photographed), textile work, drawings, paintings etc.

Portfolios - selection and presentation

- Time and care are needed in selecting work and presenting it in the portfolio. Obvious repetition should be avoided, and unfinished work may be included.
- Work should be grouped together in sections according to subject matter, individual projects or the medium used.
- All students are limited to a maximum of 20 pages and portfolios must not be larger than A2.
- Candidates are requested to leave their portfolios at the school office on Monday 18th November. Portfolios will be available to collect from the school office on Friday 22nd November. Please ensure that portfolios are clearly labelled with the candidate's name and current school.

Supervised test

Candidates will spend 90 minutes in the art room where they will be asked to demonstrate their drawing and observational skills in response to a set task.

Music Scholarship

The assessment process

The candidate should be competent and have evidence to support the Grade they are on, or working towards, on one instrument. Candidates applying for a Music Scholarship will be required to perform two prepared pieces on the instrument or instruments of their choice (or voice). Candidates will be invited to attend a workshop which will take place during the week commencing 24th November 2025. Your invitation will state the date and time.

If more than one instrument is to be offered, then the candidate should prepare one piece on their first and second instrument.

- It is regarded as an advantage to be able to offer more than one instrument; however, the audition panel is primarily concerned with assessing musical potential.
- We will be available to accompany both vocal and instrumental performances.
- If the candidate wishes to present any further skills i.e. composition work, they may do so.
- Please bring a portfolio containing any certificates relevant to the candidates musical achievements so far along to the audition.

Copies of the music to be performed must be attached to the Scholarship Application Form and returned by the 10th of November 2025. Please indicate whether an accompanist will be required.
