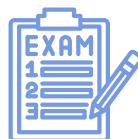

Application fee

A non-refundable application fee of £120 is payable at the time of application.

Acceptance deposit

On accepting a place, an acceptance deposit of £1,500 is payable. This is automatically refunded after the pupil has left.

Fees payment

Fees are payable monthly via direct debit or in termly instalments.

The school runs a cashless policy we do not accept cash or cheques.

A full term's notice of withdrawal must be given in writing on or before the first day of term, prior to the leaving date, or payment of a full term's fees will be required in default of such notice.

Fee increases are agreed in Feb/March for the following academic year in line with our budget setting cycle.

Any increase to fees will be notified to all parents in writing giving at least one term's notice before the increase applies.

Sibling discount: While two (or more) siblings are at the school, a reduction of no more than 10% can be made in respect of the fees of the younger sibling(s). This is only eligible for the second and subsequent child attending simultaneously. (Full Terms & Conditions are available on request from the School Office)

Morning session 8.30am - 12.15pm	£51 inclusive of lunch
Afternoon session 12.15pm - 3.15pm	£15 sundry charge per day* £39 exclusive of lunch (no funding)
Full day 8.30am - 3.15pm	£66 inclusive of lunch with funding* £90 inclusive of lunch (no funding)

*A sundry charge includes optional items such as healthy and nutritious snacks, nappies, wipes, cream, use of the school facilities, specialist teaching and any other consumable resources, that are not integral to the delivery of the EYFS. It also includes activities such as outsourced workshops, events, celebrations, or any other activities that are not directly related or necessary for the effective delivery of the EYFS statutory framework.

This is not an exhaustive list, if parents wish to bring in their own consumables, they should request more detailed information about what they will need to provide.

A full term's notice must be given in writing on or before the first day of term prior to the leaving date, or payment in default of such a notice will be required. A full term's notice is also required to reduce the number of sessions your child attends in the Nursery section of the School (or otherwise change your child's EY funding requirements).

We are unable to claim EY funding for any child not in attendance at our setting.

Adhoc sessions: of less than a full terms notice, will be charged at the full standard rate. EY funding is only applicable to PM sessions.

Childcare vouchers and tax free childcare GOV.UK payments: can be used towards school fees, up until the final term of Nursery only. After then, we can accept them for after school club and breakfast club only.

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
